WELCOME TO ALBANIA

Albania (Shqipri or Shqipëria), officially the **Republic of Albania**, is a country in Southeastern Europe. The country is located in the Balkans on the Adriatic and Ionian Seas within the Mediterranean Sea and shares land borders with Montenegro to the northwest, Kosovo to the northeast, North Macedonia to the east, and Greece to the south. Spanning an area of 28,748 km² (11,100 sq mi), it displays a varied range of climatic, geological, hydrological, and morphological conditions. Albania boasts significant diversity, with the landscape ranging from the snow-capped mountains in the Albanian Alps and the Korab, Skanderbeg, Pindus, and Ceraunian Mountains to the hot and sunny Albanian Adriatic and Ionian Sea Coasts. Tirana is its capital and largest city in the country, followed by Durrës, Vlora, and Skodra.

Tourism

Tourism in Albania Albania has been a key element of the country's economic activity and is constantly developing. It is characterized by its rich archaeological and cultural heritage, dating back to the classical period when Illyrians and Ancient Greeks inhabited the region. Over the course of history, the territory of Albania has been occupied and populated by Romans, Byzantines, Venetians, and Ottomans. Notably, the country features unspoiled beaches, mountainous landscapes, traditional cuisine, archaeological artifacts, unique traditions, low prices, and the wild atmosphere of the countryside.

The country lies in Southeastern Europe, bordering Montenegro to the northwest, Kosovo to the northeast, North Macedonia to the east, and Greece to the south. The Mediterranean Sea, Adriatic Sea, and Ionian Sea make up the entire west border of the country. The country's coastline length is about 481 km (299 mi), composed of both sandy and rocky beaches, bays, caves, cliffs, capes, and lagoons. [1] Although the country features notable diversity with the landscape ranging from the snow-capped Albanian Alps, Sharr, Skanderbeg, Korab, Pindus, and Ceraunian Mountains to the sunny Albanian Adriatic and Ionian Sea Coasts.

The country has a distinctly Mediterranean climate. Across the country's territory, there is a wide range of microclimates due to differing soil types and topography. The warmest areas of the country are found along the coasts, where the climate is profoundly impacted by the sea, while the coldest parts are in the northern and eastern hinterlands, where a snowy, forested climate is prevalent.

With a total of 3.8 million visitors, Albania is the 25th most visited country in Europe. [3] Lonely Planet ranked Albania as the number one destination to visit in 2011. The New York Times ranked Albania 4th among 52 destinations to be visited in 2014. Although still underdeveloped, Albania is set to make its world debut as it celebrates a century of independence. A Huffington Post article outlined 10 reasons for visiting Albania in 2013. Recently, Albania has been officially dubbed "Go Your Own Way". Previously, it was dubbed "A New Mediterranean Love". According to the Albanian Institute of Statistics, around 4.73 million foreign citizens visited Albania in 2016.

WELCOME TO TIRANA

General Presentation for Tirana

Tirana was declared the temporary capital on February 8, 1920, by the Congress of Lushnja and finally received this status on December 31, 1925. Tirana has been the world capital of the Bektashi since 1925, the year when the Bektashi were banned and expelled from Turkey. Tirana is located in the center of Albania, about 35 km to the east of Durres and about 40 km to the north-west of Elbasan. The city of Tirana is the largest city in Albania and the largest economic, administrative, political, industrial, media, academic, social, and cultural center of the country. Tirana is located only 17 kilometers away from “Mother Teresa” airport, the international airport in Albania known as Rinas. This airport is the most important connecting entrance between Albania and the rest of the world. In the century XVII, Tirana had about 4000 inhabitants.

Geographic data

Tirana, with an area of 1,110.03 km², is located 110 meters above sea level. The average height of the plain of Tirana is 521 m, while the two highest mountains at the base of which it lies are Dajti Mountain (1612 m) and Mali me Gropa (1828 m). The city is located about 34 kilometers from the Adriatic Sea in the west. From the south and west, it is surrounded by relatively low hills, while from the northwest, Tirana lies on a flat area. In Tirana, a subtropical-Mediterranean climate prevails, with winter rainfall and average annual temperatures of +24 °C in July and +7 °C in January. 1 189 mm of rain falls per year.

The river Tirana runs through its northern outskirts. A few kilometers further from the southern sideflows the River Erzen. Before the administrative reform of 2014, the area of the city of Tirana was about 31 km², while the area of the whole district was 1288 km² and included four centers: Tirana, Vora, Krrab, and Kamza, as well as 150 villages. After the administrative reform, the municipality of Tirana expanded to 1,110.03 km², while the districts as administrative units were merged. Tirana is also part of the district of Tirana, which includes five municipalities: Tirana, Kamza, Vora, Kavaja, and Rogozhina. The center of Tirana is crossed by the Lana stream, which joins the Ishëm river at its mouth. Tirana is located on the same parallel with Naples, Madrid, and Istanbul and on the same meridian with Budapest and Krakow.

Culture, tradition and tourism

The capital of Albania, like any European metropolis, is rich in terms of the energy and vibrancy it offers. Visiting this young city, full of cafes, bars, taverns, and nightclubs, is a pleasure and entertainment in itself. The young and dynamic population, as well as the hospitality that characterizes it, create curiosity and interest for those who visit it for the first time. There are a number of hypotheses about the name of the city. Some of them refer to the name Tyrrenia (an ancient Etruscan name). Others think that the city was called Theranda (which means harvest), as well as Tirkan, the name of an old castle at the foot of Dajti mountain.

The exploration of Tirana can start by visiting the museums or the main points, a good part of which are located in the central square of the city, called “Sknderbej” square. The center of Tirana was designed by the well-known Italian architects of the Mussolini period, Florestano de Fausto and Armando Brasini. The Palace of the Brigades (former royal palace), the buildings of the Ministries, the National Bank, and the City Hall are their works.

In the square, there is also the monument to the National Hero, Skenderbeu. The Skanderbeg monument, erected in 1968, is the work of Odhisa Paskali in collaboration with Andrea Mano and Janaq Paço. It was established on the occasion of the 500th anniversary of the death of the national hero.

There you can see the mosque of Et'hem Beu (built in the period between 1798 and 1823) or the Clock Tower, inaugurated in 1822, which is 32 meters high. Although an oriental-style monument, it is topped by a dome of the San Marco type. The special feature of this tower, which is open to visitors today, is that until 1971, it was the tallest building in Tirana.

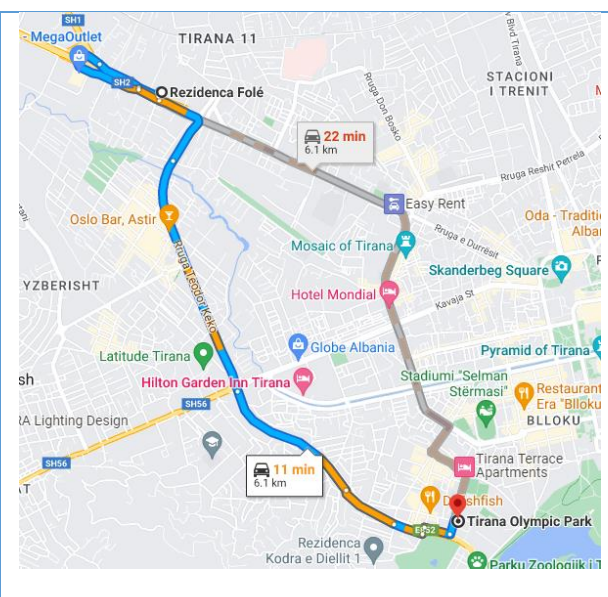
