BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

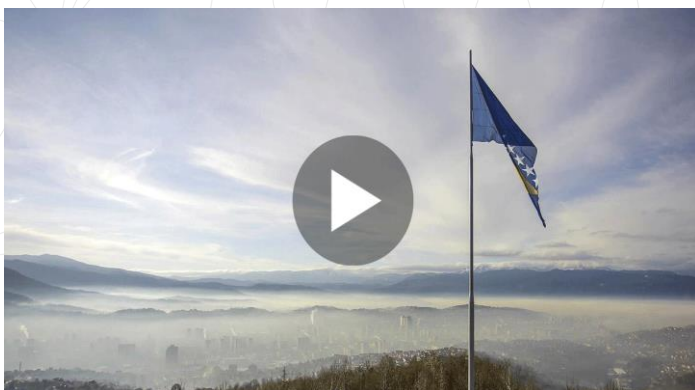
ABOUT BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Bosnia and Herzegovina is a country in Southeast Europe, situated on the Balkan Peninsula. It borders Serbia to the east, Montenegro to the southeast, and Croatia to the north and southwest. In the south it has a 20 kilometres (12 miles) long coast on the Adriatic Sea, with the town of Neum being its only access to the sea. Bosnia has a moderate continental climate with hot summers and cold, snowy winters. In the central and eastern regions, the geography is mountainous, in the northwest it is moderately hilly, and in the northeast it is predominantly flat. Herzegovina, the smaller, southern region, has a Mediterranean climate and is mostly mountainous. Sarajevo is the capital and the largest city.

NATURAL BEAUTY

Bosnia and Herzegovina, a land of natural splendor and captivating beauty, invites you to discover its picturesque landscapes and unspoiled treasures. Nestled in the heart of the Balkans, this enchanting country boasts a diverse tapestry of scenery that ranges from majestic mountains to serene rivers and lush valleys.

Explore the rugged peaks of the Dinaric Alps, where pristine forests and meadows stretch as far as the eye can see. SARAJEVO

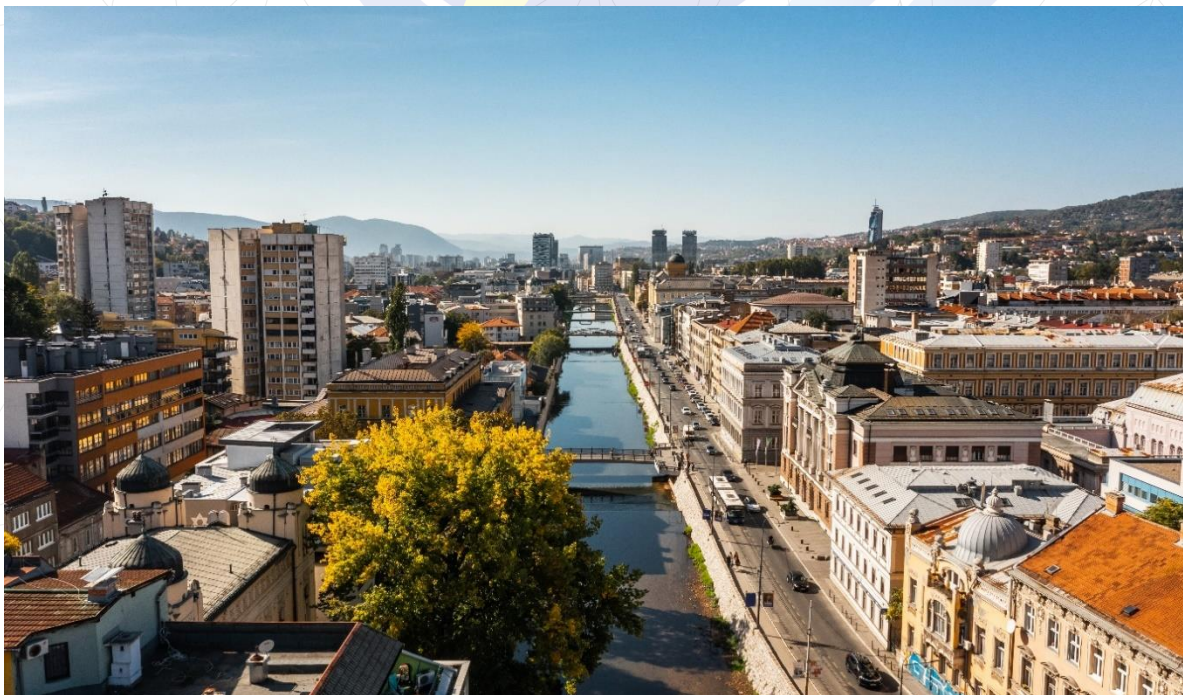
HOST CITY

Sarajevo is the capital of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Federation of BiH. Cantonal authorities must ensure full protection of the interests of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Federation of BiH in the Sarajevo Canton.



The territory of the Canton covers the areas of the municipalities of Centar Sarajevo, Hadžići, Ilidža, Ilijaš, Novi Grad Sarajevo, Novo Sarajevo, Stari Grad Sarajevo, Trnovo and Vogošća as defined under the Peace Accord.

The Sarajevo Canton is located in the Dinaric Alps ridge, at a meeting point of two large natural-geographical units, namely the Podunavlje part of the Danube river basin and the Adriatic Sea. It covers the area of 1.268,5 km² which makes up for 2.5 % of the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina. The Sarajevo Canton is between 43°35' and 44°07' north latitude, and between 18°0' and 18°38' east longitude. The distance between the northernmost point of the Canton and the southernmost is 62 km, with 52.5 km between the western and eastern point. The total length of the Sarajevo Canton border is 303.5 km.



Religious landscape of Sarajevo is unique in Europe – due to its diversity, the city is often compared to Jerusalem. Sarajevo is the seat of the Grand Mufti, the head of the Islamic Community in Bosnia and Herzegovina, the seat of the Dabro-Bosnian Metropolitan of the Serbian Orthodox Church, and the seat of the Vrhbosna Archdiocese of the Roman Catholic Church in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Downtown Sarajevo, at just a hundred meters away, is a home to many sacred buildings of four world religions – mosques from the Ottoman times, Orthodox, Roman Catholic and Evangelical churches, the synagogue and other cultural and historical landmarks.

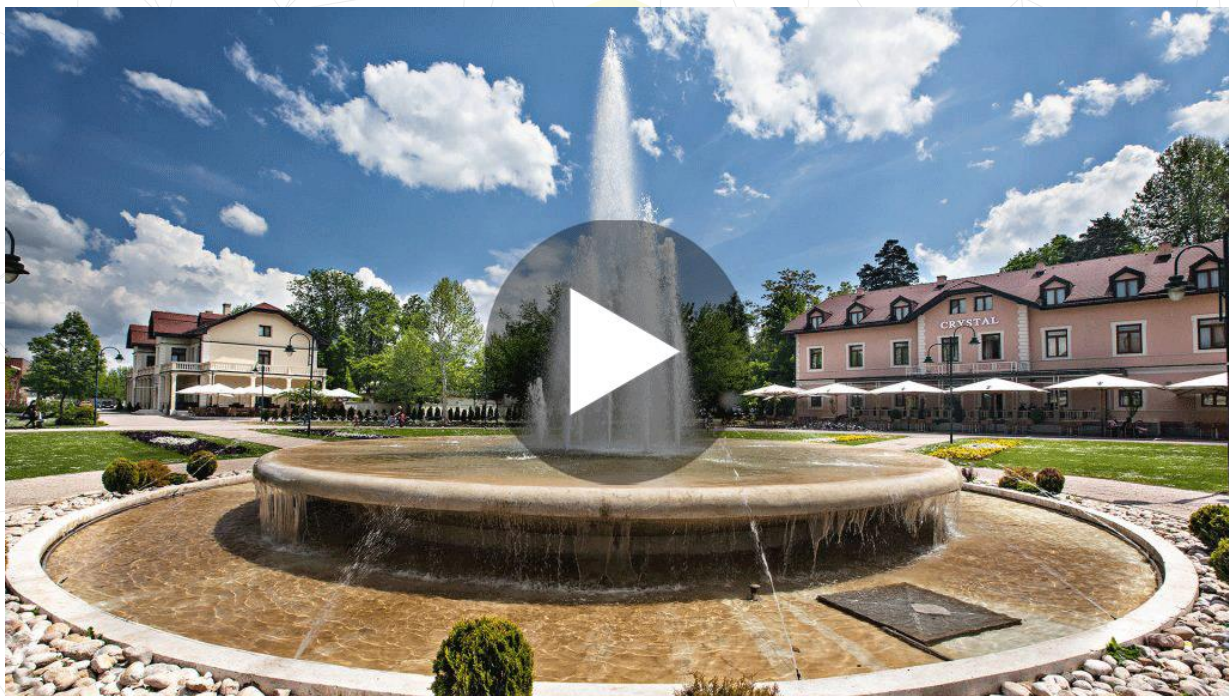


ILIDŽA

MUNICIPALITY

Ilidža is a spa town and a municipality located in Sarajevo Canton of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, an entity of Bosnia and Herzegovina. It has a total population of 66,730 with 63,528 in Ilidža itself, and is a chief suburb of Sarajevo and de facto its neighborhood. It is best known for the Vrelo Bosne spring, as well as the natural environment of its surroundings and historical tradition dating back to Neolithic times. Sarajevo International Airport is located nearby.

Ilidža is known to have a pleasant and attractive geography. The town itself is built on fairly level ground, although it is surrounded by mountains. The biggest is Mount Igman, whose 1,502 m (4,928 ft) peak towers above the town. On the mountain grows the "Golden Lily" (*Lilium bosniacum*), a branch of the Lily family of flowers that is a historical symbol of Bosnia. The area is rich in flint, especially in the Butmir neighborhood.

VRELO BOSNE

Vrelo Bosne is a public park and a protected Nature Monument established around the source of the Bosna river, featuring the system of numerous springs at the foothills of Mount Igman, in the municipality of Ilidža.



ROMAN BRIDGE

The Roman bridge is a bridge located in Ilidža. It was built in the 16th century using actual Roman stones and crosses the Bosna river. The Roman Bridge is located not far from Vrelo Bosne on the Bosna river in the Ilidža municipality. It was constructed sometime between 1530 and 1550 from the original Roman stones and ruins of the bridge that stood there during the Roman period.

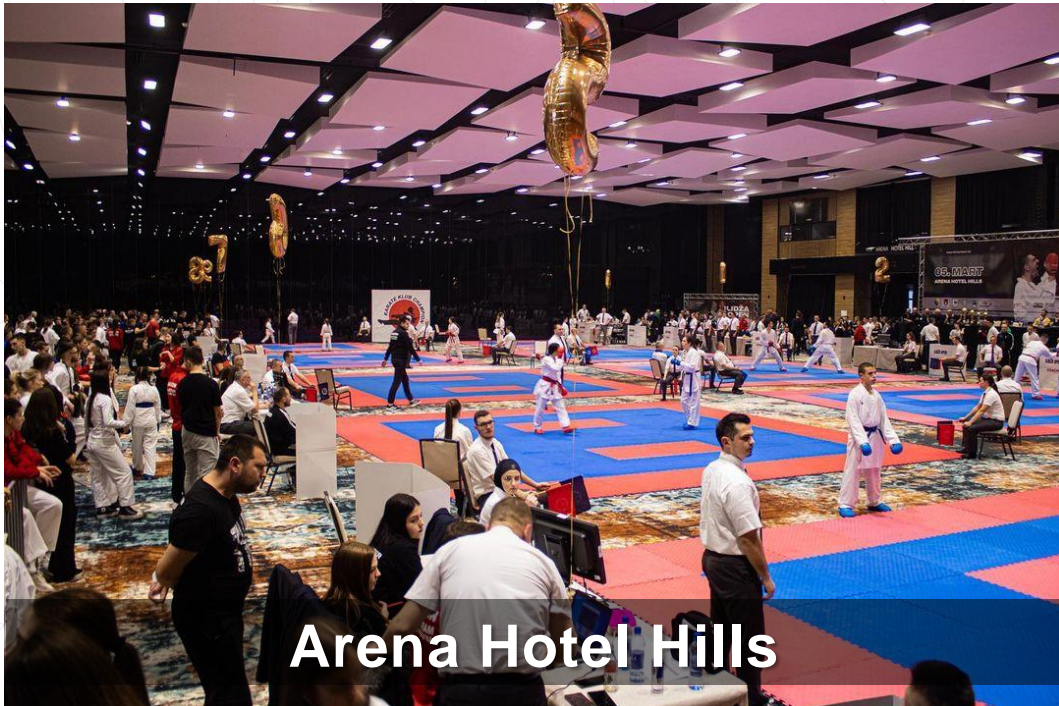

REGISTRATIONS, ACCREDITATION AND WEIGH-IN

ON-SITE REGISTRATION

Only the head of delegation of every NF should come to the registration and accreditation area with all necessary documentation for all competitors and other members of delegation.

Steps will be as following:

1. The Head of the delegation receives the list of registered participants for reviewal (participants that are registered online)
2. In case of changes, the registration and accreditation team updates the list
3. The Head of the delegation prepares all passports according to the final list
4. The accommodation team compares the registration list to the rooming list to ensure that all registered participants are accommodated in the official accommodation
5. The Head of the delegation makes payments according to the final registration list
6. The accreditation team issues accreditation cards

WEIGH-IN

Weigh-in will be organized for every national federation after the successful registration and accreditation procedure. Weigh-in will happen in hotels 60 minutes after the end of registration and accreditation procedure for every national federation.

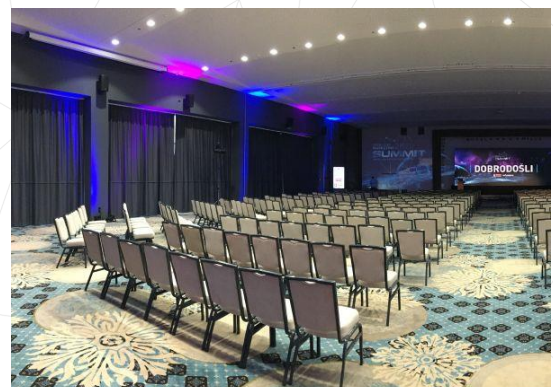
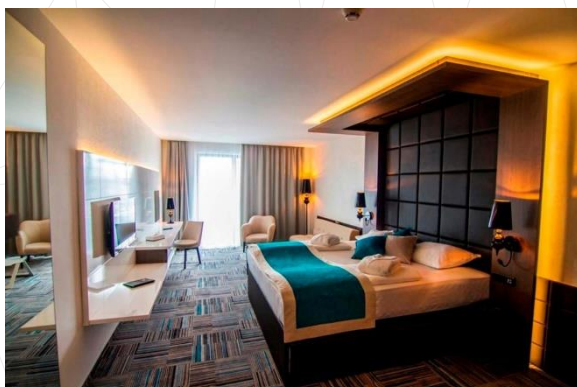
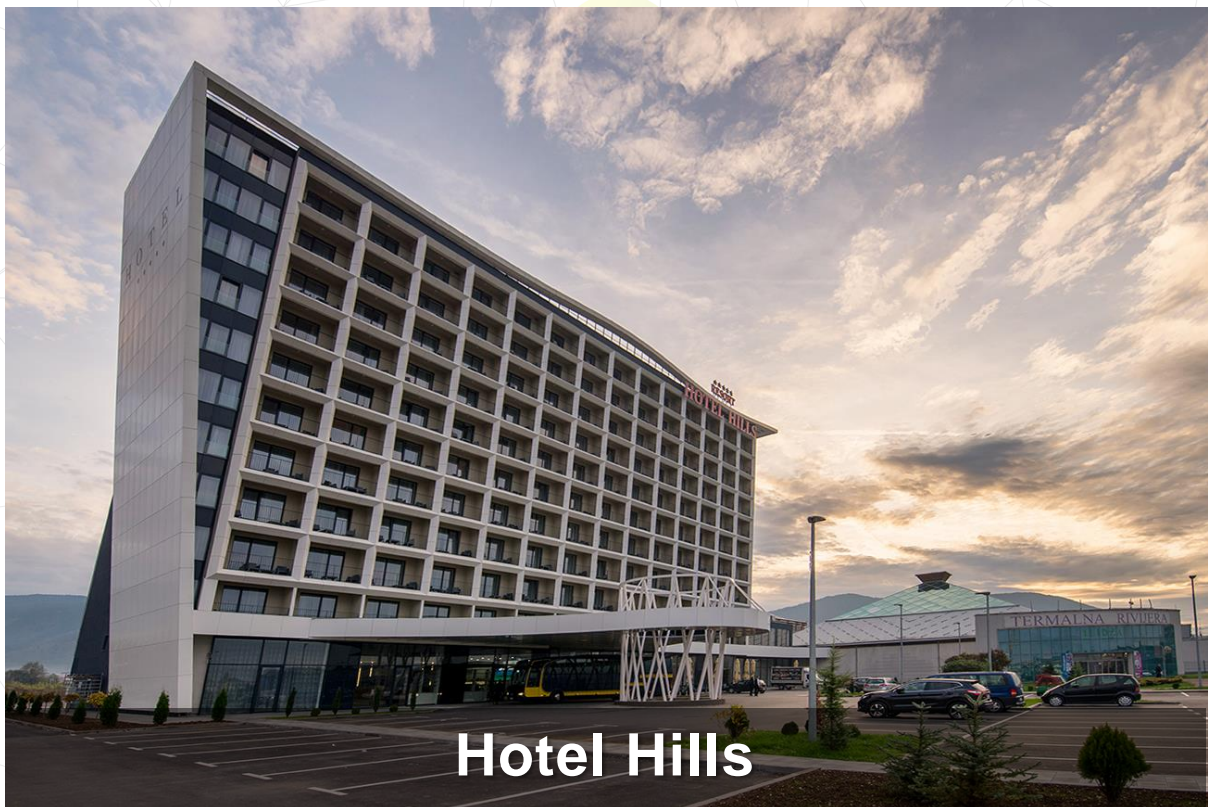
ACCOMMODATION

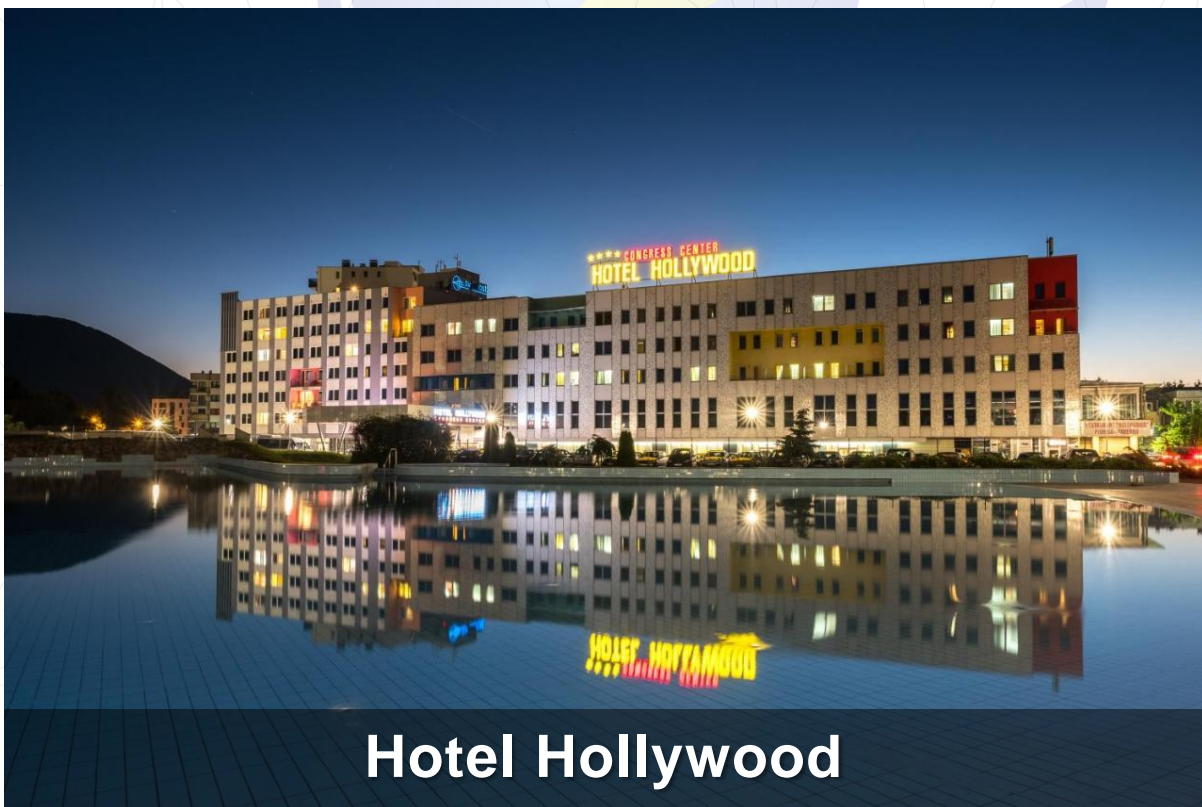

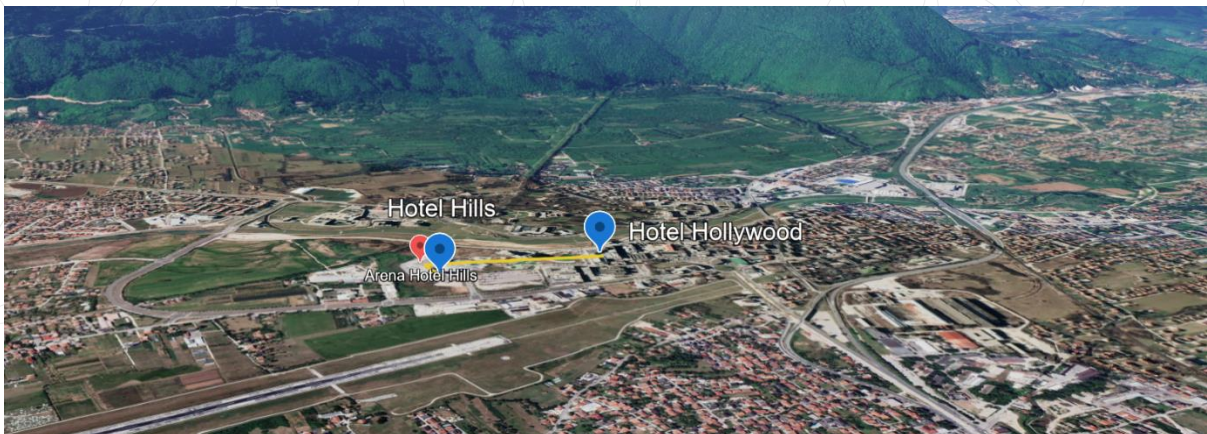
