2. INTRODUCTION

The Karate 1 - Premier League is the most important league event in the world of Karate. It comprises of a number of the most prominent Karate competitions and endeavours to bring together the best Karate athletes in the world in an open Championships of unprecedented scale and quality.

Initiated in 2011, the 2025 edition is formed by four events being held in the cities of Paris, Hangzhou, Cairo and Rabat thus stating Karate's impact all around the world and its global scale.

At the final Premier League event 2025, the top-ranked athletes in each category are presented with the "Grand Winners" award. In order to be eligible to receive the "Grand Winners" award, competitors have to participate in at least 3 events.






7.1 Competition System

The competition system consists of two different phases:

8. EVENT RANKING

Competitors can earn ranking points in every Karate 1 event according to the official WKF Ranking as can be seen in Section 2 (Points per Place) and Section 4 (Points Calculating System) of the WKF Ranking Rules.

The participation will be limited to the first 100 competitors of the WKF Event Ranking.

The <u>Event Ranking</u> is defined as a static file which reflects on the ranking on the opening day of the online registration for a given event: 24/11/2024

EVENT RANKING

9. ONLINE REGISTRATION & OFFICIAL ACCREDITATION

Registration starts two (2) months prior to the event, on 24/11/2024 at 12:00 h GMT +0 and close fifteen (15) days before the tournament, on 09/01/2025 at 12:00 h GMT +0

All registration in a Premier League event must be processed ONLINE.

No registration will be accepted after the official online registration deadline and all requests will be declined.

Onsite registrations will NOT be accepted.

Registrations subjected to the payment of a registration fee will not be validated until the payment is completed through the online payment platform.

Onsite payments will NOT be accepted.

Individuals and National Federations are responsible for the quality of the entered registration data.

The online registration will be openly disclosed for everyone from the beginning, allowing consultation by WKF NFs of the events participants registered in real time.

Any issue regarding online registration has to be notified to the software provider and to the WKF, latest five days before the first day of competition, in order to allow taking them in consideration without altering the smooth running of the process.

9.1 Athletes Registration

Athletes registration is divided in the following three phases (all phases will open and close at the 12:00 h GMT +0 of the listed day);

PHASE 1

<u>From 24/11/2024 to 01/12/2024</u> (first week for registration)

Registration only by NFs for athletes classified between the positions 1 and 32 (included) in the Event Ranking

No limit of athletes per NF

<u>From 02/12/2024 to 09/12/2024</u> (second week for registration)

Open registration for athletes classified between the positions 1 and 32 (included) in the Event Ranking

No limit of athletes per NF

PHASE 2

From 10/12/2024 to 17/12/2024 (next two weeks of registration)

If vacancies, open registration <u>for athletes ranked between positions 33 and 64</u>
(included) in the <u>Event Ranking</u>

No limit of athletes per NF.

PHASE 3

From 18/12/2024 to 09/01/2025 (last two weeks of registration)

If vacancies, open inscription <u>for competitors ranked between positions 65 and 100</u>
(<u>included</u>) in the <u>Event Ranking</u>

No limit of athletes per NF.

All competitor registrations must be made ONLINE

9.1.1 Entry Fee

The entry fee is € 150 per each individual entry.

9.1.2 Payment

All payments must be processed through the ONLINE PAYMENT PLATFORM. Onsite payments will NOT be accepted.

9.1.3 Non-Reported Absences

- Any cancellation of an online registration must be <u>for a justified and duly accredited cause</u> and must be communicated in writing to the WKF (<u>wkf@wkf.net</u>) at least <u>48 hours before the first day of the competition</u>. <u>Title</u>: PL Absence + (event) + (WKF ID)
- 2. In case of an unjustified absence, the athlete will not be able to register in the following TWO (2) Karate 1 Premier League events.
- 3. If the unjustified absence occurs at the last Karate 1 Premier League event of the year, the athlete in question will not be eligible for the Grand Winner title either.

9.1.4 Replacement List

- 1. You may sign up for the <u>Replacement List</u> when a category is full (32) by selecting your desire category during the normal registration process, after which payment will not be request and your entry will be listed as Replacement List 'Category'.
- 2. The Replacement list is **only** to as a means of contacting the athlete if and entry declares their absence prior to the event. It does in **NO WAY** imply or suggest that you have been registered for the event, or that you have been promised a place in the event.

Contacting a Replacement

- 1. If an absence is confirmed via WKF, then, the first registered athlete will be contacted immediately **by email** with instructions to complete the entry fee payment within a strict 24 hours.
- 2. Failure to complete the registration within the 24 hours will lead to the complete removal of the entry and the next person on the replacement list will be contacted.
- 3. After the registration closes, you can still be put your name onto the replacement list manually by writing the WKF (wkf@wkf.net) up to 7 days before the competition. **Title**: PL Replacement List + (event) + (WKF ID)





9.2 Referees Registration

Only Referees with a WKF Kata Judge-A and/or Kumite Refere-A license are entitled to officiate at Premier League events.

The Referee Ranking applicable for Paris 2025 PL will be the one of the opening day of the online registration, 24/11/2024.

All **referee** registrations must be made **ONLINE**





9.3 Coaches Registration

All coach must be in possession to the WKF Kumite o Kata Coach Certification (Coach level 2) to officiate at Premier League events.

All coach registrations must be made ONLINE

9.4 Official Onsite Accreditation

The official onsite accreditation will take place on Thursday, 24/01/2025, from 10.00 h to 12.00 h at the Pierre de Coubertin Stadium (Court n°3)

If changes are required during the official registration session, due to incorrect or missing registration data, a fee of € 50 is charged for each change.

The athlete's accreditation must contain an updated photograph that allows the athlete to be identifiable throughout the event.

Accreditation cards will be issued at registration, displaying the participants' main data, photograph and information about registered categories. The accreditation card must be carried at all times during the event.

Only members of national federations recognized by WKF are admitted participating, as per the Karate 1 - Premier League Organising Rules 2025

All participants must submit an official passport for the WKF identification and validation at the accreditation session.

The accreditation of all the competitors must be done by the athlete or the athlete's coach, in person bringing the athlete passport at the accreditation session.

Any competitor who may not have collected their accreditation during official registration, either personally or through their delegate, will not be included in the Draw.

The weighing will be carried out immediately after receiving the accreditation, those athletes who will not attend the weighing <u>will not be included in the Draw</u>.







10. MANDATORY DOCUMENTS

MANDATORY DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED AT THE OFFICIAL ACCREDITATION

At the onsite registration, all participants (Coach, Athletes, Referees, Officials) must submit a printed and signed Waiver of Liability form.

If the back number is not properly sewn, it can be a reason for disqualification.





13. WKF COACH PROGRAMME

According to the WKF Coach Educational Programme, the minimum certification required to take part in Karate 1 – Premier League events is the "Kumite or Kata certification" (level 2). To obtain such certification, coaches must pass the corresponding Kumite or Kata examination.

The Kumite or Kata coach licence can be obtained

- through the WKF E-learning platform for Coaches; https://www.elearning-wkf.net/
- or by attending to one of the Programmes for Coaches that the WKF held in official events.

A WKF Programme for Coaches will be held in all Karate 1 - Premier League events 2025.

Only coaches in possession of the "WKF Accredited Coach" level have access to the "WKF Kumite or Kata certification".

14. MEDIA

14.1 TV Production

All the events of the 2025 Karate 1 - Premier League will be produced for international distribution on TV. The Sunday competition will be available to a worldwide audience through high-quality TV production provided to TV networks around the world following the agreements of the WKF.

Due to these agreements, <u>VIDEO RECORDING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED UNDER ANY</u> CIRCUNSTANCE.

14.2 YouTube Streaming

The eliminations of the 2025 Karate 1 – Premier League will be available by streaming on WKF YouTube Channel.

Additionally, the medal bouts will be available to stream on the WKF YouTube Channel. However, they will be limited to countries without TV rights.

In the countries where TV networks have acquired the rights to distribute the events, the medal bouts will be available only on the <u>listed TV channels</u>.

14.3 Press

Press accreditation can only be given to professional journalists working for a media and having proof of their credentials.



19.2 How to get to Paris

By Air:

Most international travelers arrive in Paris via Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG) or Orly Airport (ORY). These airports have excellent connections to the city center by train, bus, or taxi.

By Train:

The Eurostar high-speed train connects Paris to major European cities, including London, Brussels, and Amsterdam, making it a convenient option for travelers coming from these destinations.

By Car:

If you're already in Europe and prefer driving, you can reach Paris by car. Be aware of parking restrictions and consider traffic conditions, especially during peak hours.

By Bus:

Several long-distance bus companies offer services to Paris from various European cities. It's usually a budget-friendly option, but the journey may take longer than by train or plane.





From Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG) to the center of Paris

RER B Train:

The RER B train is a popular and cost-effective option. The CDGVAL shuttle train connects the airport terminals to the RER B station. From there, you can take the RER B train to various central locations in Paris, including Gare du Nord, Châtelet-Les Halles, and Saint-Michel-Notre-Dame. The journey takes approximately 30-40 minutes. Trains run regularly, typically every 10-15 minutes.

Airport Shuttle Bus:

Orlyval Light Rail + RER B Train:

Take the Orlyval light rail from Orly Airport to the Antony station. From Antony, transfer to the RER B train, which will take you to various central locations in Paris, including Gare du Nord, Châtelet-Les Halles, and Saint-Michel-Notre-Dame. This journey typically takes around 30-40 minutes by train.

Orlybus:

Orlybus is a dedicated shuttle bus service that connects Orly Airport to central Paris. It runs from Orly to Denfert-Rochereau station, which is well-connected to other parts of the city. The journey usually takes about 20-30 minutes.





<u>Tramway T7 + Metro:</u>

The T7 tram connects Orly Airport to the Villejuif - Louis Aragon metro station on Line 7. From there, you can take Line 7 of the Paris Metro to reach central locations in the city. The entire journey may take around 30-40 minutes.

Taxi:

Taxis are available at Orly Airport. The travel time by taxi to the city center typically ranges from 30 to 45 minutes, depending on traffic conditions.

Private Transfer:

Consider booking a private transfer in advance if you prefer a more comfortable and hassle-free option, especially if you have a lot of luggage or are traveling with a group.

Ridesharing Services:

Ridesharing services like Uber are also available at Orly Airport, offering a convenient door-to-door option.
