MONTENEGRO

ABOUT MONTENEGRO

Montenegro (Montenegrin: Crna Gora), is located in South-eastern Europe. It has a coast on the Adriatic Sea to the south-west and is bordered by Croatia to the west, Bosnia and Herzegovina to the northwest, Serbia to the northeast, and Albania to the southeast. Its capital and largest city is Podgorica, while Cetinje is designated as the Prijestonica, meaning the former Royal Capital City.

The country got its name (literally, "black mountain") from the dark, mountain forests that cover the land. Some 60 percent of the country is more than 1,000m high, with the tallest peak Bobotov Kuk (Durmitor) reaching to 2,522m.

The coast of Montenegro is 294km long. A notable feature of the Montenegrin coast is Bay of Kotor, a fjord-like gulf, which is in fact a submerged river canyon. The Bay of Kotor is surrounded by mountains up to 1,000m high, which plunge almost vertically into the sea.

NATURAL BEAUTY

Back in 19th century, Lord Byron wrote "At the birth of our planet, the most beautiful encounter between the land and the sea must have happened at the coast of Montenegro. When the pearls of nature were sown, handfuls of them were cast on this soil." Montenegro still retains its natural charm and beauty. Architecture dating back to the 12th Century is still prevalent among the many UNESCO heritage towns and villages. Montenegro's natural beauty is dramatic; mountains dropping down to mirrored water in the UNESCO heritage Kotor bay and the crystal clear waters of the Adriatic lapping the sandy beaches of the coast. Although the gulf of Kotor is commonly referred to as a fjord, it was not formed by glacial movement and is in fact a ria (a drowned river canyon), but is by common consent, spectacular. Drive into the mountains to find undrowned river canyons (the Tara canyon being the second deepest in the world), glacial lakes, untouched nature and a fledgling ski and eco-tourism industry. On the coast, the climate is Mediterranean rising to 40 degrees in August, but cooler inland where the climate is Continental.

LAKE SKADAR NATIONAL PARK


When you go towards the sea from Podgorica Airport, you will find unexpectedly beautiful scenery. An expanse of turquoise water, covered with a carpet of waterlilies, interrupted by numerous islands... Welcome to the heart of Montenegro – Lake Skadar National Park! 222 km² of this remarkable ecosystem has been protected since 1983, and it has been on the Ramsar List of Wetlands of International Importance since 1995.

LOVČEN NATIONAL PARK

Here you can find one of the top places you have to visit while you are in Montenegro – Njegoš's mausoleum. This monument, to which you have to climb up 461 steps, is at the same time the grave of the ruler, poet, and philosopher Petar II Petrović Njegoš.

DURMITOR NATIONAL PARK

As you are getting closer to Žabljak, through gentle pastures, you will start to suspect that this is a special place. These 39,000 hectares of true, untouched beauty were declared a protected area in 1952, and is found on the UNESCO list of World Natural and Cultural Heritage. Besides the mountain giant Durmitor, the national park also covers the Tara, Draga, Sušica, and Komarnica Canyons, and Europe's most recently explored canyon – Nevidio.

BAR-MONTENEGRO



BAR

The modern town with wide boulevards, surrounded by Mediterranean vegetation, the largest touristic and nautical centre at the entrance to the Adriatic Sea. Numerous cultural and historical monuments, the most important of which is the Old Town of Bar, situated 4 km away from the coast, are witnessing the turbulent history of the town. Today, its postcard consists of tourist facilities, restaurants, shops, sports fields and a marina with 1,150 berths.

Two equally beautiful shores of the municipality of Bar - the Adriatic Sea, which is 46 km long with 9 km of beaches, and Skadar Lake which is 65 km long, are ready to satisfy the diverse tastes of tourists. The names given to the beaches by the very tourists speak of their attractiveness and beauty: Pearl Coast, Golden Coast, Queen's Beach, Red Beach, etc.

The location of Old Bar provides an opportunity for visitors to experience the panorama of the green Bar field, the new part of the town, the port, the open sea and Rumija mountain massif from the walls of the ramparts. A special attraction of Old Bar is the marketplace, where sellers dressed in traditional costumes of this region offer customers local products such as citrus fruits, olives, olive oil, cheese and various homemade handicrafts.

OLD OLIVE TREE

The Old Olive Tree, the symbol of Bar, is the oldest tree in Europe, more than 2,242 years old.

It is located in the settlement of Mirovica, on the fifth kilometre from Bar to Ulcinj. This natural monument is older than any written monument about Bar and its inhabitants. The Old Olive Tree in Mirovica is a natural monument protected by law in 1963. The diameter of the tree is 10 metres.

According to the legend, conflicted families gathered around the olive tree to make peace with one another – hence the name Mirovica (“peace” translates to “mir”).

REGISTRATIONS, ACCREDITATION AND WEIGH-IN

REGISTRATION

Deadline for registration of competitors and teams is May 23rd, 2025. To apply, it is necessary to use on line www.sportdata.org section "Karate".

ON-SITE REGISTRATION

Only the head of delegation of every NF should come to the registration and accreditation area with all necessary documentation for all competitors and other members of delegation.

Steps will be as following:

1. The Head of the delegation receives the list of registered participants for reviewal (participants that are registered online)
2. In case of changes, the registration and accreditation team updates the list
3. The Head of the delegation prepares all passports according to the final list
4. The accommodation team compares the registration list to the rooming list to ensure that all registered participants are accommodated in the official accommodation

5. The Head of the delegation makes payments according to the final registration list
6. The accreditation team issues accreditation cards

WEIGH-IN

Weigh-in will be organized for every national federation after the successful registration and accreditation procedure. The weigh-in will take place at the hotel where the competitors are accommodated 60 minutes after the completion of the registration and accreditation procedure for each national federation..

INFORMATION AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Pursuant to Article 57 of the Statute of the KFB in competitions organized by Karate Federation of Balkan (KFB) can participate:

- Judges delegated by KFB,
- Athletes who are duly registered and in time according to the schedule and have made a payment of registration fee before the event,
- Officials (referees, coaches, representatives of the national karate federation) and athletes who are placed in the OFFICIAL HOTELS published in the Bulletin.

All competitors must bring with them their own gloves and belts (red and blue) and all other protective equipment approved by the WKF.

USEFUL INFORMATION ABOUT MONTENEGRO

LANGUAGE: The official language is Montenegrin (Serbian), but nearly everyone speaks English.

Currency: EUR. Bank offices are open from 8.00 to 16.00 from Monday to Friday.

Weather: Days are usually hot and sunny, so visitors should pack summer clothes, but nights can be chilly. The average daily maximum is 28° C and the average daily minimum is 19° C.

Time: GMT+2.

Electricity: 220V. Montenegro uses a standard plug with two round pins.

Phone: Prefix is +382 check with your phone provider to see what roaming charges you might incur.

Visa: Not necessary for citizens of any SSEKF member state.

Emergency telephone number: Ambulance/Police/SOS 112
