2. INTRODUCTION

The Karate World Championships (Individual World Championships) have a 2-year qualification period along with a quota allocation system of a total of 32 quotas per category. The Karate World Championships Competition System is composed of 2 phases: the Group Phase (Round–robin - Rr) and the Elimination Phase with no repechage. Each category will have 1 gold, 1 silver and 2 bronze medallists.

The Para-Karate World Championships will also be held during this event. National Federations can register up to 3 athletes per category. In the group system of the Para-Karate competition, groups of eight to twelve athletes are formed. In each round, the number of athletes per group is reduced to 4 until only two groups remain. Each category will have 1 gold, 1 silver and 2 bronze medallists.

3.2 Competition System Karate World Championships

The Karate World Championships Competition System is composed of 2 phases: the Group Phase (Round–robin - Rr) and Elimination Phase with no repechage

Group Phase (R-r)

The number of groups depends on the final participation. Each group will always have a maximum of 4 athletes and a minimum of 3 athletes. The group phase will be conducted in a Round-Robin system.


The group winners and their runners-up will qualify for the Elimination Phase.



Elimination Phase

After the Group Phase, the group winners and their runners-up will move to the Elimination Phase where each athlete has 1 bout per round and the winners continue on while the losers are eliminated. In total, there are 4 elimination rounds: the first elimination round – called Round of 16, the Quarterfinals, the Semifinals, and the Medal Bouts.

The winners of the Semi-finals will compete in the final, while the two Semi-finals losers, along with the two quarterfinalists defeated by the finalists, will compete in the bronze medal bouts, as is shown in the following brackets:



R16: Round of 16


QF: Quarter-Finalist



11. REGISTRATION

11.1 Karate World Championships

Photographs of athletes and officials participating in the Cairo World Championship must be recent and comply with passport or ID card format requirements. Images that do not meet these standards will not be accepted for official accreditation.

Athlete registration for the Karate World Championships -Individual World Championships- is based on the allocation criteria defined in the point 2.1 of the Qualification and Competition System for Karate World Championships document.

11.1.1 Online Registration for Delegations (Athletes, Coaches and Officials)

The online registration will start on 27 August 2025 at 12:00 (GMT+0) and will close on 12 November 2025 at 12:00 (GMT+0)

National Federations will only be available to register the athletes who have qualified following point 2.1 of the <u>Qualification and Competition System for Karate World Championships</u> document and that have confirmed their participation.

All registration in the Karate World Championships must be processed online.

ONLINE REGISTRATION

No registration will be accepted after the official online registration deadline.

Onsite registration will not be accepted.

11.2 Para-Karate World Championships

11.2.1 Online Registration for Athletes

The online registration will start on 27 August 2025 at 12:00 (GMT+0) and will close on 27 October 2025 at 12:00 (GMT+0)

All athletes registered shall be first places on the waiting list.

PARA - KARATE REGISTRATION

Submission of Medical Documentation:

During the registration procedure upload all essential Para Karate athlete's medical documentation to the Sports ID Para-Karate athlete's profile (these uploaded documents do not need to be sent by email to the HQ).

Only those athletes having their documents uploaded until the end of registration and having an eligible impairment (see the list of eligible impairments) may be moved from the "waiting list" to the actual list of registered athletes for the event.

The Head of Para-Karate classification can ask for supplemental medical documentation to prove the underlying health condition of the athlete.

The mandatory forms can be found in the following links:

For all athletes:

- Athlete Evaluation Consent Form
- WKF Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) Application Form (only in case the athlete uses WADA prohibited medication)

For Visually Impaired Athletes: K10 Medical Diagnostic Form For Wheelchair Athletes: K30 Medical Diagnostic Form

For Intellectually Impaired Athletes: K21 and K22 Medical Diagnostic Form

K21 and K22 Eligibility Guidance Notes

K22 AAI Screening (athletes classified before

2023)

To be considered eligible to compete as an athlete with an intellectual impairment (K21 and K22), athletes must fulfil the full eligibility criteria as defined by VIRTUS.

We suggest you contact your national representative of the VIRTUS (International Sports Federation for Athletes with an Intellectual Impairment) https://www.virtus.sport/member or your National Paralympic Committee at least 12 weeks before the event. However, should you require any assistance, or there is no VIRTUS representative in your country, please contact the Para-karate Commission Chairwoman at wkfparakarate@gmail.com to be able to solve any incidents in time for the WKF Championships.

All documents MUST be attached in English for ALL registered athletes. All MDFs must be completed by a registered Medical Doctor, M.D.



Selected athletes must attend the classification session. The list of selected athletes will be uploaded o Sportdata system one day before the classification session.

Please see the <u>Para-Karate registration checklist</u> before the completion of the registration of the Para Karate athletes.

Submission of Medical Documentation:

Athletes who do not submit the mandatory medical documentation, properly filled out and signed by a medical doctor, will be removed from the list after 10 November 2025.

Medical Review by WKF Para-Karate Commission:

Deadline: 17 November 2025

Athletes will be removed from the waiting list after this date if:

- o They do not meet the Minimum Eligibility Criteria.
- They have not been confirmed to the WKF by the VIRTUS office.

Para-Karate athletes per category

Every National Federation has the opportunity to register three (3) Para-Athletes per sport class. In total, 24 athletes can be called by each nation.

Classification Session

Classification in Para-Karate K10 and K30 sport classes consists in an extra point compensation depending on the influence of the particular impairment when performing the Kata. Detailed information can be found in the Para-Karate regulations: https://www.wkf.net/sport-parakarate.

Please, check the Para-karate Classification rules to ensure that the athlete presents at least one of the mentioned eligible impairments which have to be proven by the MDF.

New registered Para-Karate athletes must present themselves for a mandatory onsite Classification Session performed by qualified personnel before the championships according to the schedule.

A timetable of classification and the list of athletes who have to attend the classification session will be published after the online registration.

Attendance to the Classification Session is obligatory for all new athletes, athletes with sport class status review listed in the classification session timetable, without a participation in such event it is not possible to take part in the championships.

Following documents have to be provided at the classification session:

- 1. Accreditation of the athlete
- 2. Passport of the athlete
- 3. Original MDFs, TUE (if necessary), Consent Form as provided prior with the registration.
- 4. Original diagnostic Report as described in the MDF for Intellectual Impairments as provided with the registration.



Following equipment must be checked at the classification session:

- FOR VISUALLY IMPAIRED ATHLETES (K10) IBSA standardized Blindfolds (Goalfix Eclipse total blackout eyeshades.
- FOR INTELLECTUALLY IMPAIRED ATHLETES (K21 and K22) sport glasses (if needed)
- FOR WHEELCHAIR USERS (K30): Competition wheelchair
 Leg straps (if needed)
 White shoes and socks for competition.

All athletes must use the same sportswear and equipment for classification as they use during competitions.

Concerning athletes with visual impairments, no extra testing will be performed during the classification session. Nevertheless, the athletes have to show up to the classification with the documents and equipment mentioned above. Extra points will be given based on the Medical Diagnostic Form.

11.3 Entry Fee

The entry fee is € 150,00.

Athletes who qualified through the Qualification Tournament or Universality Places will not be required to pay the registration fee for the Final Phase of the Karate World Championships Cairo 2025.

11.5 Onsite Accreditations

The onsite accreditation will take place at the HQ Hotel, room CANYON-1, on 26 November 2025 from 09h to 16h.

The accreditation of athletes and officials will be handed over to the representative of the National Federation upon presentation of the passport of each athlete and official.

Onsite accreditations change fee: 50 EUR as per the WKF Fees & Conditions.



12. REFEREES

The minimum level required for referees to register and officiate at Karate World Championships is:

"Kumite Referee A and Kata Judge A"

The Referees categories allowed to register in Karate World Championships Cairo 2025 (see "Conditions and Requirements for Referees 2025") are listed below;

- a. WKF Referee Commission
- b. The WKF will appoint 30 Referees, complying with the established requirements, and will assume for each of them a benchmark lump sum for the flight as well as the full board accommodation in one of the official hotels. Criteria to be considered for the appointment of these 30 Referees will be:
 - Highest WKF license Kumite Referee-A and Kata Judge-A
 - Compliance with the Referees' requirements for attending a WKF World Championships, including one extra Premier League
 - o Activity attendance according to the WKF Referee Ranking
 - Universality (Continental Federations)

The list of 25 referees will be published before the start of the online registration on 15th July.

c. NFs will be allowed to register a maximum of two (2) referees with Referee Kumite A and Kata Judge A license per NF that comply with the overall established annual requirements (see above), regardless of those Referees belonging to their NF already included with those appointed by the WKF under points a) and b) above.

The online registration will start on 15 July 2025 at 12:00 (GMT +0) and will close on 1 October 2025 at 12:00 (GMT +0).

All registrations for the Karate World Championships 2025 must be processed online.

REFEREE REGISTRATION

No registration will be accepted after the official online registration deadline.

Onsite registration will not be accepted.

All registrations for the Karate World Championships Cairo 2025 must be processed online.

No registration will be accepted after the official online registration deadline.

Onsite registration will not be accepted.

13.3 Specific information for PARA-KARATE Coaches and personal assistants

The minimum WKF Coach certification to performer as Para-Karate Coach is the WKF Certified Kata Coach (level 2 of the WKF Coach Programme).

Maximum of three coaches can be registered for Para-Karate per Nation.

Every Para-Karate athlete can be accompanied by a personal assistant during their performance in the field of play.

Coaches and assistants accompanying Para-Karate athletes MUST register together with their delegation at the onsite registration session only.

All athletes must use the same sportswear and equipment for classification as they use during competitions.

Concerning athletes with visual impairments, no extra testing will be performed during the classification session. Nevertheless, the athletes have to show up to the classification with the documents and equipment mentioned above. Extra points will be given based on the Medical Diagnostic Form.

14. MEDIA AND PRESS

14.1 Media Accreditation

MEDIA REGISTRATION

Press accreditation can only be given to professional journalists working for a media and having proof of their credentials. The media passes may be collected at the accreditation desk at the venue during the competition days and also at Registration Day.

14.2 Media Access

Access to media work areas is restricted to credentialed journalists and photographers covering the event. Accredited journalists will only have access to the designated Media areas (Press Tribune, Mixed Zone).

14.3 TV Production

The WKF owns all the rights pertaining to TV issues of the Karate World Championships.

The Karate World Championships will be broadcast on a number of TV and media platforms. The competition will be available to a worldwide viewing audience through a high-quality TV production which will be provided to TV networks around the world following the agreements of the WKF with these networks.

Due to these agreements **VIDEO RECORDING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE**.



No credentialed media may take video footage (including digital) without prior written consent from the WKF. Only TV rights holders will be allowed to film and record footage of the competition. The WKF reserves the right to revoke credentials for unprofessional behaviour or conduct.

14.4 YouTube Streaming

The eliminations of the 2025 Karate World Championships will be available by streaming on WKF YouTube Channel

Additionally, the medal bouts will also be available by streaming on the <u>WKF YouTube Channel</u> limited to those countries without TV rights.

In the countries where TV networks have acquired the rights to distribute the event, the medal bouts will be available only on the <u>listed TV channels</u>.

14.5 Media Day

The WKF will host a Media Day at the Registration Area on 26th November 2025, from 10:00h to 17:00h. The photos of all the participating athletes will be taken by the WKF Media Team at the Media Day.

This activity is of the utmost importance for the promotion and popularity of the event on social media; therefore, the WKF encourages all participating athletes to take part in this Media Day.

15. MANDATORY DOCUMENTS





28. THE HOST CITY

28.1 About Cairo

Cairo is the capital and largest city of Egypt. The Cairo metropolitan area, with a population of 21.3 million, is the largest metropolitan area in the Arab world, the second largest in Africa, and the sixth largest in the world. Cairo is associated with ancient Egypt, as the famous Giza pyramid complex and the ancient city of Memphis are located in its geographical area. Located near the Nile Delta, Cairo was founded in 969 AD during the Fatimid dynasty, but the land composing the present-day city was the site of Ancient National Capitals whose remnants remain visible in parts of Old Cairo. Cairo has long been a centre of the region's political and cultural life, and is titled "the city of a thousand minarets" for its preponderance of Islamic architecture

29. HOW TO GET TO THE CHAMPIONSHIPS

29.1 By Air

The most common way to get to Cairo from other countries is by air.

The local airline is Egyptair, but most European airlines have direct connections to Cairo.

It is also possible to fly within Egypt, but only Egyptair flights operate in this case. CAIRO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT is the most important airport in Egypt and the second busiest airport in Africa.

It consists of three terminals, all of which are connected by a free shuttle bus that runs all day.

Located about 22 kilometres from the city centre, there are several options for getting there.

29.2 By Bus

This is the cheapest way to travel from Cairo Airport to the city centre, specifically to Tahir Square.

There are two lines available: line 400 24 hours a day and line 500 until 22:00 h.

Frequency is 20 minutes.

Cairo Airport Shuttle Bus:

This is a direct minibus service, operating from 06:00 to 23:00 h.

They depart from Terminals 1 and 3 and stop in the centre and outskirts of Cairo, including Heliopolis, Giza, Zamalek and Haram.



Prices vary according to destination. Check the official website for routes and book inadvance.

Taxi:

Taxis are one of the most convenient ways to travel from Cairo Airport to the city centre butbe aware of the different types of taxis.

Black and white taxis require you to agree on a fare before you travel.

Transfers:

Finally, there is the alternative of pre-arranging a transfer from Cairo Airport to your hotel.

The advantage is that they are already priced and can be booked in advance.

City transportation:

City transportation in Cairo is provided by metro, bus, taxis (UBER, CAREEM), and minibuses.

Metro is the most preferred public transport, but the most popular and convenientamong tourists is to hire a daily taxi.

In Cairo, the metro is the most preferred means of transportation by people. The metro lineswhich have been in operation since 1987, are expanded each year as the city expanded andnowadays have a large network covering almost the whole city. You can travel around in thefastest way by using the metro line which has 61 stations, 3 of which are transfer stations.

Cairo has a large public transport network with city buses, MwasalatMisr buses, and minibuses serving in the city. Many bus lines stop in the city center, such as Ramsis Station. Youcan find vans almost everywhere but they are usually very crowded and not so comfortable.

Mwasalat Misr is a private company and has its own buses and transportation services that they provide in a wide area in the city.

Taxis (UBER, CAREEM) are the most popular way of transportation in Cairo for tourists.

With the choice of many private taxi companies, you can hire taxis for your trip plan and choose the one that suits you best in price. Many different brands are giving private transportation services in Cairo, but also you can find an official taxi to go around.

Prices may differ but you have a chance to negotiate with the drivers.

30.5 Weather

In Cairo the weather in November is generally perfect, with low temperatures and rainfall in some days. Daytime temperatures hover around 25°C, while nights can cool down to about 17°C.

There is a meduim rain in Egypt during November, so it's a lot easier to explore the city. Just remember to dress in warm layers, as it can still get pretty chilly.
