2. INTRODUCTION

The WKF Karate 1-Series A is a world-class competition that provides karatekas around the world with more competitive opportunities to shine at the highest level. Presented in an open format thus allowing every athlete in the world to compete, the Karate 1- Series A is framed under the umbrella of the Karate 1 to bring together the best competitors in a series of open championships of unprecedented scale and quality. In addition to this, the Karate 1-Series A offers karatekas the chance to increase their ranking position as the universality of top Karate tournaments is showcased.

While maintaining the individual character of each event, all Series A events have to meet certain standards in order to achieve the above-mentioned goals. Therefore, it is necessary to follow these Karate 1 – Series A Organizing Rules 2025.

All members of WKF are admitted participating. The competition categories are identical to those of Senior World Championships except for Kumite team.

The number of competitors for **Kumite** modality is limited to a maximum of 96 athletes per category.

For **Kata** modality the number of competitors is limited to a maximum of 128 athletes.

The WKF Competition Rules in force will be applied.

Competitors of individual categories earn ranking points in every WKF Karate1 event according to the official WKF World Ranking regulations.



9. RANKING

Competitors can earn ranking points in every Karate1 event according to the official WKF Ranking Criteria, point 3.2 of the WKF World Ranking Rules.

The participation will be limited to those competitors from position 33 onwards of the WKF ranking.

The applicable ranking will be the one updated on the day of the registration opening, on 05/06/2025. This ranking is called the **Event Ranking** and can be found on the event registration page. It is a **static file** that does not change unlike the current ranking which updates during each ranking update.

10. ONLINE REGISTRATION & OFFICIAL ACCREDITATION

Registration starts three (3) months prior to the event, on 5th June 2025, and close fifteen (15) days before the tournament on 21st August 2025 at 12:00 hrs GMT +0

All registration in a Series A event must be processed ONLINE.

No registration will be accepted after the official online registration deadline and all requests will be declined.

Onsite registrations will NOT be accepted.

Registrations subjected to the payment of a registration fee will not be validated until the payment is completed through the online payment platform.

Onsite payments will NOT be accepted.

Individuals and National Federations are responsible for the quality of the entered registration data.

The online registration will be openly disclosed for everyone from the beginning, allowing consultation by WKF NFs of the events' participants registered in real time.

Any issue regarding the online registration has to be notified to the software provider and to the WKF, latest five days before the first day of competition, in order to allow taking them in consideration without altering the smooth running of the process.

10.1 Athletes Registration

The participation will be limited to those competitors from position 33 onwards of the SA Salzburg Event Ranking.

Athletes' registration is divided in the following two phases (all phases will close at the 12:00 hrs GMT +0 of the listed day)

- Phase 1, from 5th June (05/06) to 19th June (19/06), 2025 (first two weeks): Registration only by National Federations for athletes ranked between position 33 and 100 (included) of Event Ranking. Maximum, 1 athlete per category.
- Phase 2, from 20th June (20/06) to 21st August (21/08), 2025: Open registration.

10.2 Referees Registration

10.3 Coaches Registration

The minimum level required to perform as a coach in Series A events is the WKF Accredited Coach Certification (Coach level 1).

10.4 Official Onsite Accreditation

The onsite official registration session will take place on 4th September 2025 from 10h to 17h at Sporthalle Alpenstraße.

If changes are required during the official accreditation session due to incorrect registration data, a fee of €50 will be charged for each change. Please note that category changes and athlete replacements will not be processed during the onsite accreditation session.

The athlete's accreditation must contain an updated photograph that allows the athlete to be identifiable throughout the event.

At registration, accreditation cards will be issued with the participants' main data, a photograph and information about registered categories. The accreditation card must be worn at all times during the event.

Only members of national federations recognized by WKF are admitted to participating, following the registration procedures described in Series A Organising Rules (SA OR Point 6 Registration).

All participants must submit an official passport for the WKF identification and validation at the accreditation session.

The accreditation of any competitor must be done by the athlete or the athlete's coach, in person bringing the athlete passport at the accreditation session.

Any competitor who may not have collected their accreditation during the official accreditation session, either personally or through their coach, WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE DRAW.

21. CITY / COUNTRY INFORMATION

21.1 About Salzburg



Salzburg, a picturesque city nestled in the Austrian Alps, captivates visitors with its rich history, stunning architecture, and vibrant culture. Known as the birthplace of Mozart and the setting for "The Sound of Music," Salzburg offers a blend of musical heritage and natural beauty. From exploring the medieval streets of the Old Town to marveling at the imposing Hohensalzburg Fortress, there's something enchanting at every turn. With its charming cafes, scenic riverbanks, and majestic mountains, Salzburg is a destination that delights the senses and leaves a lasting impression on all who visit.

21.2 How to get to Salzburg

Getting to Salzburg is relatively easy, thanks to its well-connected transportation network. Here's a simple guide on how to reach this charming Austrian city:

By Air:

Salzburg Airport (W.A. Mozart Airport) is the main gateway for international travellers. It's located just a few kilometers west of the city center. Direct flights from major European cities are available, making it convenient for travellers arriving from abroad. From the airport, you can take a taxi, shuttle bus, or public transportation to reach the city center.



Arriving at Munich Airport: Munich Airport, also known as Franz Josef Strauss Airport (MUC), is one of Germany's largest and most well-connected airports. Upon arrival, follow the signs to baggage claim and passport control if you're arriving from an international destination.

By Train:

Salzburg Hauptbahnhof (main train station) is a major rail hub with frequent connections to domestic and international destinations. The station is well-served by trains from Vienna, Munich, Innsbruck, Zurich, and other European cities. If you're traveling within Austria, consider using the efficient ÖBB (Austrian Federal Railways) network. From the train station, you can easily reach the city center by bus, taxi, or on foot.

Transfer from Munich to Salzburg by Train: The most convenient way to reach Salzburg from Munich Airport is by train. The airport has its own train station called "München Flughafen Terminal," located directly beneath Terminal 1. From there, take the S-Bahn (suburban train) line S1 or S8 towards Munich Hauptbahnhof (main train station). The journey to the main station takes approximately 40-45 minutes.

21.3 Practical Information

Language: The official language of Austria is German, and German is spoken widely in Salzburg. However, English is also commonly spoken, especially in tourist areas, hotels, and restaurants. You should have no trouble communicating in English during your visit.

Time Zone: Salzburg is in the Central European Time Zone (CET), which is UTC+1. Daylight Saving Time (DST) is observed from the last Sunday in March to the last Sunday in October when the time is shifted one hour forward (UTC+2).

22. GENERAL INFORMATION

22.1 Currency and Exchange

The currency used in Salzburg, and throughout Austria, is the Euro (€). ATMs are widely available in the city, and credit cards are accepted at most shops, restaurants, and hotels. However, it's always a good idea to carry some cash for small purchases and transactions.

22.2 Business Hours

Most shops and retail stores in Salzburg are open from around 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM or 7:00 PM, with some variation depending on the individual store. Some larger stores may stay open until 8:00 PM or later, especially in the city center.



Supermarkets and grocery stores usually operate from early morning until late evening, often until 8:00 PM or 9:00 PM.

Many cafes and bakeries in Salzburg open early in the morning, around 7:00 AM or earlier, to serve breakfast. Restaurants typically serve lunch from around 12:00 PM to 2:00 PM. Dinner service usually starts around 6:00 PM or 7:00 PM and can continue until 10:00 PM or later, especially in the city center. However, it's a good idea to check specific restaurant hours and make reservations in advance, especially during peak tourist seasons.

22.3 Electricity

In Salzburg, as in the rest of Austria and much of Europe, the standard voltage is 230 volts and the frequency is 50 Hz.

22.4 Alcohol

The legal drinking age in Austria, including Salzburg, is 18 years old. It's illegal for anyone under this age to purchase or consume alcoholic beverages in public places.

22.5 Tobacco

Austria has strict smoking regulations, which include designated smoking areas in public places such as restaurants, bars, and public transportation. Smoking is generally prohibited in enclosed public spaces, including public buildings and workplaces.

22.6 Safety in the city

Salzburg is generally a safe city for tourists. However, as with any destination, it's essential to take common-sense precautions to protect yourself and your belongings from petty theft or pickpocketing, especially in crowded tourist areas.
