5.4 Onsite Registration & Accreditations

Registration will be arranged in HQ Hotel on Tuesday, 19th May from 09:00 to 15:00 hours (Mainhaus Hotel, room “Alte Kapelle”)

Each change made after the closure of the online registration, as well as each new onsite registration, will incur a surcharge fee of 50 € per individual, in addition to the correspondent registration fee.

Timeslots will be given out by alphabetical order. Delegations that miss their time for registration, can register during the open registration session from 1:30 - 3:00 p.m.

 - Athletes who do not have mandatory medical documentation filled out and signed by a medical doctor will be removed from the list after 29th April 2026.
- **The deadline for reviewing medical documentation by WKF Para Karate commission is 11th May 2026.**
 - Athletes who do not meet the minimum eligibility criteria will be removed from the waiting list after **11th May 2026**.
 - Athletes who have not been confirmed to the EKF by the VIRTUS office will also be removed from the waiting list after **11th May 2026**.

8.4 Para Karate registration

- All athletes registered shall be on the waiting list.

- During the registration procedure upload all essential Para Karate athlete's medical documentation to the Sports ID Para Karate athlete's profile (these uploaded documents do not need to be sent by email to the HQ).
- Only those athletes having their documents uploaded until the end of registration and having an eligible impairment ([see the list of eligible impairments](#)) may be moved from the “waiting list” to the actual list of registered athletes for the event.
- An athlete without eligible impairment according to the WKF Para Karate rules and regulations will not be moved from the waiting list.
- The Head of Para Karate classification can ask for supplemental medical documentation to prove the underlying health condition of the athlete.

- To be considered eligible to compete as an athlete with an intellectual impairment (K21 and K22), athletes **must fulfil the international eligibility criteria as defined by VIRTUS.**
- Athletes must have their VIRTUS international eligibility confirmed to EKF by the VIRTUS office at the end of registration. Athletes who do not meet the VIRTUS eligibility requirements will be removed from the waiting list and will not be able to compete.
- We suggest you contact your national representative of the VIRTUS (INAS) <https://www.virtus.sport/member> or your National Paralympic Committee at least 12 weeks before the event. However, should you require any assistance, or there is no VIRTUS representative in your country, please contact the Para-karate Commission Chairwoman at ekf@ekf.com.es to be able to solve any incidents in time for the EKF Championships.

All documents MUST be attached in English for ALL registered athletes.
All MDFs must be completed by a registered Medical Doctor, M.D.

- Selected athletes must attend the classification session on 21st May 2026.
- Please see the [Para Karate registration checklist](#) before the completion of the registration of the Para Karate athletes (schedule of the classification will be uploaded on Sportdata download section at least one day before the classification (it depends on the number of registrations)).

8.5 Para Karate athletes per category

Every nation can register three (3) Para-Athletes per sport class. In total, 24 athletes can be called by each nation.

8.6 Classification session

Classification in Para Karate K10 and K30 sport classes consists in an extra point compensation depending on the influence of the particular impairment when performing the Kata. Detailed information can be found in the Para Karate regulations: <https://www.wkf.net/sport-parakarate>.

Please, check the Para Karate Classification rules to ensure that the athlete presents at least one of the mentioned eligible impairments which have to be proven by the MDF.

- New registered Para Karate athletes must present themselves for a mandatory onsite Classification Session performed by qualified personnel before the championships. The Classification Session will therefore be performed on 21st May.
- A timetable of classification and the list of athletes who have to attend the classification session will be published after the registration online.
- Attendance to the Classification Session is obligatory for all new athletes, for athletes with sport class status review listed in the classification session timetable.
- Without a participation in such event, it is not possible to take part in the championships.

The following documents must be provided at the classification session:

1. Accreditation of the athlete.
2. ID card or Passport of the athlete.
3. Original MDFs, TUE (if necessary), Consent Form as provided prior with the registration.
4. Original diagnostic Report as described in the MDF for Intellectual Impairments as provided with the registration.

The following equipment must be checked at the classification session:

- FOR VISUALLY IMPAIRED ATHLETES (K10) - IBSA standardized Blindfolds (Goalfix Eclipse total blackout eyeshades).

- FOR INTELLECTUALLY IMPAIRED ATHLETES (K21 and K22) – sport glasses (if needed).
- FOR WHEELCHAIR USERS (K30):
 - Competition wheelchair
 - Leg straps (if needed)
 - White shoes and socks for competition.

8.7 Coaches and personal assistants

- Maximum of three coaches can be registered for Para Karate per Nation.
- Any coach wishing to be registered will need to be in possession of the EKF Kumite and/or Kata Coach certification level.
- Every Para Karate athlete can be accompanied by a personal assistant during their performance in the field of play.
- Coaches and assistants accompanying Para Karate athletes **MUST** register online via the following [link](#).
- All athletes must use the same sportswear and equipment for classification as they use during competitions.
- Concerning athletes with visual impairments, no extra ophthalmological testing will be performed during the classification session. Nevertheless, the athletes have to show up to the classification with the documents and equipment mentioned above. Extra points will be given based on the Medical Diagnostic Form.
- During the medal bouts, male coaches and personal assistants are required to wear a dark suit, shirt, and tie while female coaches and personal assistants may choose to wear a dress, pantsuit or a combination of jacket and skirt in dark colours.

8.8 Rules

8.9 Anti-Doping

In compliance with WKF Anti-Doping Rules and WADA, Para Karate athletes will be subject to any eventual testing. If any Para Karate athlete would need a Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE), please contact your National Anti-Doping Organization for further details and recognition. The duly recognized TUE at national level will then have to be duly communicated to the WKF.

9. COACHES PROGRAMME

Please find below all information of the Programme for EKF Coaches that is going to be taking place in Frankfurt (Germany) on occasion of the 61st European Senior Championships 2026.

The minimum level required for coaches to take part in EKF Championships is the:

“EKF Kumite/Kata Coach” certification (coach level 2)

It is possible to homologate a WKF Kumite and/or Kata Coach (coach level 2) license by the EKF, only during the online registration period, until 5th May 2026. After this date no homologations will be accepted.

To do so, you must fill in the form: [“Request for the Homologation of a WKF Coach Certification by the EKF”](#) and send it to the e-mail; ekf@ekf.com.es, together with the bank proof of payment of the homologation fee.

After receiving the written approval of EKF homologation, you can register to officiate as a coach at the event.

Note: The WKF Accredited Coach license (coach level 1) is not homologated by the EKF.

For those withing to obtain a EKF Coach license, successful participation in the EKF Coaches' course is required.
