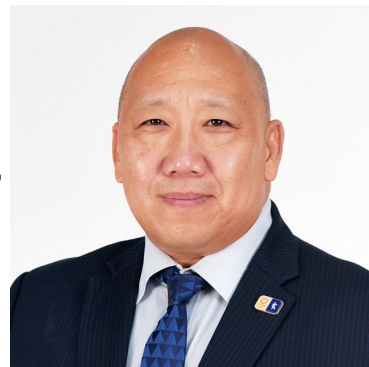

2. INTRODUCTION

The Karate One – Youth League is a competition conceived to highlight the impact of Karate in young ages.

Established under the umbrella of Karate One and designed to complete Karate One -Premier League and Karate One - Series A, the Karate One - Youth League aims to become a platform for the development of youngsters in their quest to progress in the sport.

The competition was devised to respond to the increasing interest of young competitors to have more options to compete at the highest level and it puts the focus on karatekas aged 12 to 17.

The number of competitors for **Kumite** modality is distributed as follows:

- **Junior:** limited to a maximum of 96 athletes per category
- **Cadet:** limited to a maximum of 96 athletes per category
- **U14:** limited to a maximum of 64 athletes per category

For **Kata** modality the number of competitors is distributed as follow:

- **Junior:** limited to a maximum of 128 athletes per category
- **Cadet:** limited to a maximum of 128 athletes per category
- **U14:** limited to a maximum of 64 athletes per category

All members of WKF are permitted to participate.

The WKF [Competition Rules](#) in force will be applied.

Under 14 (12 - 13): 11 categories (9 Kumite + 2 Kata)

- Female Kumite: - 42kg, - 47kg, -52kg, +52kg

- Kata: Female, Male

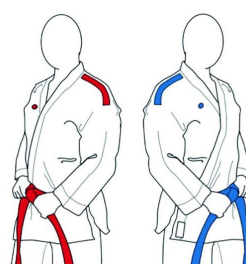

8. RANKING

Competitors can earn ranking points in every Karate One event according to the official WKF Ranking Criteria, point 3.2 of the WKF World Ranking Rules. For more information about ranking rules click [here](#).

The current ranking is based on a dynamic file, getting updated at the beginning of each month and after each event on the [WKF Event Calendar](#).

The Event Ranking is defined as a static file which reflects on the ranking on the opening day of the online registration for a given event.

9. ONLINE REGISTRATION & OFFICIAL ACCREDITATION

Registration in a Youth League event must be processed ONLINE.

The registration will be validated once online payment is completed through the payment platform.

No registration will be accepted after the official online registration deadline.
Any requests after that will be declined.

Onsite registrations will NOT be accepted.

Registrations subjected to the payment of a registration fee will not be validated until the payment is completed through the online payment platform.

Onsite payments will NOT be accepted.

Individuals, Clubs and National Federations are responsible for the quality of the entered registration data.

The online registration record will be openly disclosed to everyone from the beginning, allowing consultation by WKF NFs of all registered participants in real time.

Any issue regarding online registration must be notified to the software provider and to the WKF, five days before the first day of competition at the latest, so that they can be properly taken in consideration without the smooth running of the process altered.

9.1 Athlete Registration

Athlete registration is divided into two phases (all phases will open and close at 12:00 h GMT +0 on the listed day):

- **Phase 1, from 16/02/ 2026 to 03/03/2026:**
 - 1st window 16/02 to 23/02 2026: Registration only by National Federations. Maximum, 1 athlete per category.
 - 2nd window 24/02 to 03/03 2026: Registration of TOP 10 athletes in the Event Ranking of each category
- **Phase 2, from 04/03/ 2026 to 29/04/2026**
 - 1st window (3 days): registration only for Kata (all age groups)
 - 2nd window (3 days): registration only for U14 Kumite
 - 3rd window (3 days): registration only for Cadet Kumite
 - 4th window (3 days): registration only for Junior Kumite
 - Afterwards: open registration with no restrictions

9.1.1 Entry Fee

The entry fees (per individual category entry) are as follows:

- Youth League events are per individual category entry is € 90.

All payments must be processed through the ONLINE PAYMENT PLATFORM. Onsite cash payments will NOT be accepted.

9.2 Non-Reported Absences

1. Any cancellation of an online registration must be for a justified and duly accredited cause and must be communicated in writing to the WKF (events@wkf.net) at least 48 hours before the first day of the competition. Title: YL Absence + (event) + (WKF ID)
2. Participation can only be refused for the following justified reasons:
 - Injury or health-related reasons.
 - Disciplinary sanctions.
 - Personal reasons (work or family nature).
3. In cases of unjustified and unaccredited absence, a €300 fine will be imposed on the athlete during the next registration for a WKF Official event.

9.3 Replacement List

1. You may sign up for the Replacement List when a category is full by selecting your desired category during the normal registration process, after which payment will not be requested and your entry will be listed as Replacement List – ‘Category’.
2. The Replacement list is only to be used as a means of contacting the athlete if an entry declares their absence prior to the event. It does in NO WAY imply or suggest that you have been registered for the event, or that you have been promised a place in the event. Penalties for Unjustified Absence

9.4 Contacting a Replacement

If an absence is confirmed via WKF, then, the first registered athlete will be contacted immediately by email with instructions to complete their payment within a strict 24 hours.

Failure to complete the registration within 24 hours will lead to the complete removal of the entry and the next person on the replacement list will be contacted.

After the registration closes, you can still be put your name onto the replacement list manually by writing the WKF (events@wkf.net) up to 7 days before the competition. Title: YL Replacement List + (event) + (WKF ID)

Weigh-in must be done on:

- Wednesday, 13/05/2026 from 12.00 a.m. to 18.00 p.m. at the HQ Hotel **for Cadet category only**.
- Thursday, 14/05/2026 from 12.00 a.m. to 18.00 p.m. at the HQ Hotel **for Junior only**.
- Friday, 15/05/2026 from 12.00 a.m. to 18.00 p.m. at the HQ Hotel. **For Junior and Cadet category only**.
- Saturday, 16/05/2026, from 12.00 a.m. to 18.00 p.m. at the HQ Hotel **for U14 category only**.

If changes are required during the official accreditation session due to incorrect registration data, a fee of €50 will be charged for each change.

Accreditation cards will be issued at registration, displaying the participants main data, a photograph and information about registered categories. The accreditation card must be carried at all times during the event.

The athlete's accreditation must contain an updated photograph that allows the athlete to be identifiable throughout the event.

Only members of national federations recognized by WKF are admitted to participating, as per the Karate One - Youth League Organising Rules 2026.

All participants must submit an official passport for the WKF identification and validation at the accreditation session.

Every competitor's accreditation must be done in person by the athlete's delegate by bringing the athlete's passport to the accreditation session.

Any competitor who may not have collected their accreditation during official registration, either personally or through their delegate, WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE DRAW.

The weigh-in will be carried out immediately after receiving the accreditation. Those athletes who fail to attend the weigh-in WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE DRAW.

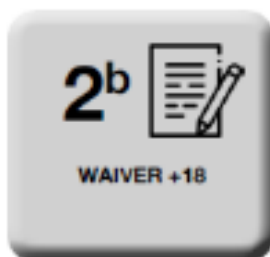

17. VISA REQUIREMENTS

As of January 2026, foreign nationals from countries not included in the Philippines' visa-free entry list must apply for a visa before travel. The Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) states that nationals whose countries are not on the visa-free list must secure an appropriate entry visa (e.g., 9A tourist visa) from a Philippine embassy or consulate prior to arrival.

Examples of Countries That Generally Require a Visa to Enter the Philippines (as of January 2026)

While visa-free entry covers nationals of about 157 countries under Executive Order No. 408, the following countries are not on that list and therefore their citizens normally must obtain a visa in advance:

For Minor 15 years old and below

A Waiver of Exclusion Ground (WEG) is required for foreign minors below fifteen (15) years of age, travelling unaccompanied by or not joining his/her parent(s) in the Philippines, regardless if the minor needs an entry visa or not.

Metro Manila (National Capital Region) is the Philippines' bustling capital, a dense urban hub comprising Manila (the historic capital city) and 15 other cities and one municipality, serving as the nation's economic, political, and cultural heart, known for its significant traffic, diverse architecture (Spanish, American, modern), major business districts like Makati and BGC, and proximity to Manila Bay

17.2 How to get to MANILA

To get to the Manila, Philippines, fly into Manila (MNL) via major international hubs, ensuring your passport is valid for at least six months and completing the mandatory **online eTravel registration within 72 hours of arrival**; you'll also need proof of onward travel and may need a visa depending on your nationality.

17.3 Practical Information

Opening times: Most shops and shopping centers are open from 10:00 AM to 9:00 PM, with extended hours until 10:00 PM on weekends. Restaurants are generally open from 10:00 AM to 11:00 PM, and some shops and pharmacies operate 24 hours a day.

How to pay: In the Philippines, people commonly pay using cash, credit card and digital wallets. Cash (Philippine Peso) is widely used, especially in small shops and public transport, while credit and debit cards are accepted in malls, hotels, and larger establishments. Digital payments like GCash and Maya are very popular for everyday transactions.

Tax free: Foreigners shopping in the Philippines are generally required to pay VAT, but eligible tourists may apply for a VAT refund on qualified purchases made at accredited stores when the items are taken out of the country.

Currency: The local currency in the Philippines is the Philippine Peso (PHP).

Electricity: In Philippines (PHI) the standard voltage is 220V at a frequency of 60Hz.

Language: Official Language in Philippines is Tagalog and English

In Philippines we use The Philippines uses Type A (two flat pins), Type B (two flat, one round grounding pin), and Type C (two round pins)
